183 Express Lanes Northbound Direct Connector from the MoPac Express Lane Now Open!

The northbound 183 Express Lanes Direct Connector, from the MoPac Express Lane to the 183 Express Lanes, is now open. A major step toward completion of the 183 North Mobility Project, this opening of the entire northbound 183 Express Lanes offers needed mobility improvements to Central Texans between US 183 and MoPac.

The northbound express lanes on US 183 opened first, on January 2, 2026, between Burnet Road and SH 45 North, and is being followed by the opening of the northbound direct connector structure from the MoPac Express Lane to the 183 Express Lanes, today, January 31, 2026.

The southbound 183 Express Lanes and southbound connection to MoPac are anticipated to open within a few months of the opening of the northbound direction, but construction timelines are always subject to change.

Drivers are encouraged to slow down and watch for signage as you familiarize yourself with the new entrance and exit opportunities now available. Express Lanes entrance and exit ramps are limited to aid drivers, transit, and emergency responders in bypassing congestion for those times that matter most.

What You Need to Know

Key things to know as the northbound 183 Express Lanes direct connector opens:



To access Loop 360 Capital of Texas Highway Great Hills Trail or Braker Lane, follow signs to exit the MoPac Express Lane toward US 183 and use the existing direct connector to the US 183 general purpose lanes.



Drivers wishing to continue on the MoPac Express Lane to the Parmer Lane exit should stay to the right to continue in the MoPac Express Lane.



Drivers should be in the left lane to take the express lane direct connector to the 183 Express Lanes. You then will continue in the 183 Express Lanes until you approach the express lane exit to Duval Road/Anderson Mill Road, bypassing Loop 360 Capital of Texas Highway, Great Hills Trail and Braker Lane.
