




Thank you to the community members who attended the 183 North Mobility Project Annual Update Event on February 23rd. The 183 North project team enjoyed





practices in honor of Distracted Driving Awareness Month and always. At least


eight people a day are killed in distracted driving crashes, according to the National

Avoid multitasking in the car.


