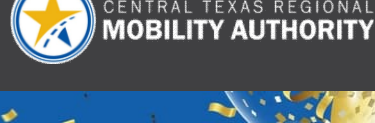




183 North Mobility Project



Celebrating One Year of Smoother Rides on the 183 North Mobility Project

One year ago, the 183 North Mobility Project reached a major milestone with the early opening of a new non-tolled lane in each direction. Delivered ahead of schedule, this key improvement was just in time for back-to-school traffic, and it's been making a positive impact ever since to help with mobility as construction continues on the project.

The goal of bringing this added capacity to the corridor is to improve traffic flow and offer much-needed relief during peak traffic hours. This milestone is just one piece of the project's broader effort to transform the 183 North corridor, with mobility infrastructure improvements that support not only drivers, but also transit users, emergency responders, cyclists, and pedestrians.

Here's to continued progress on the 183 North Mobility Project and many more milestones to come!

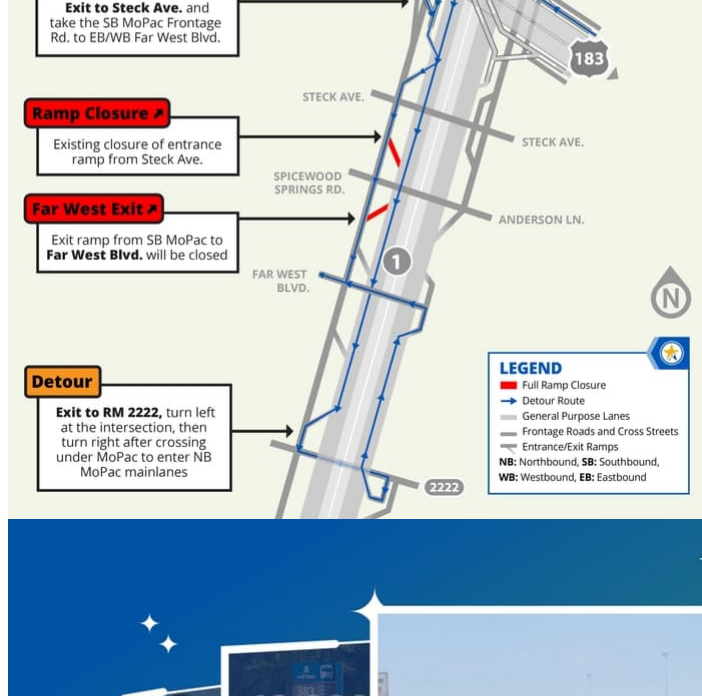


Collector-Distributor Touchdown

It's going to be a win for commuters! The new direct connector/collector-distributor road structure we're building has officially **touched down** to ground level, and this special moment is making us even more excited as we gear up for football season!

Whether you're heading to the game or just tackling your daily commute, once the 183 North Mobility Project is complete, this interchange improvement between US 183 and MoPac is designed to reduce congestion and improve overall travel times.

Closure of Exit to Far West Blvd. from MoPac General Purpose Lanes

The 183 North Mobility Project crews have closed the Far West Boulevard exit from southbound MoPac, likely for the remainder of 2025 to facilitate construction of operational improvements to the US 183 and MoPac interchange coming as a part of the 183 North Mobility Project. Alternate routes are available. This work is part of the last phase of construction closures in this area as the 183 North Mobility Project nears completion.



Paving the Way: 183 North Sidewalk Series

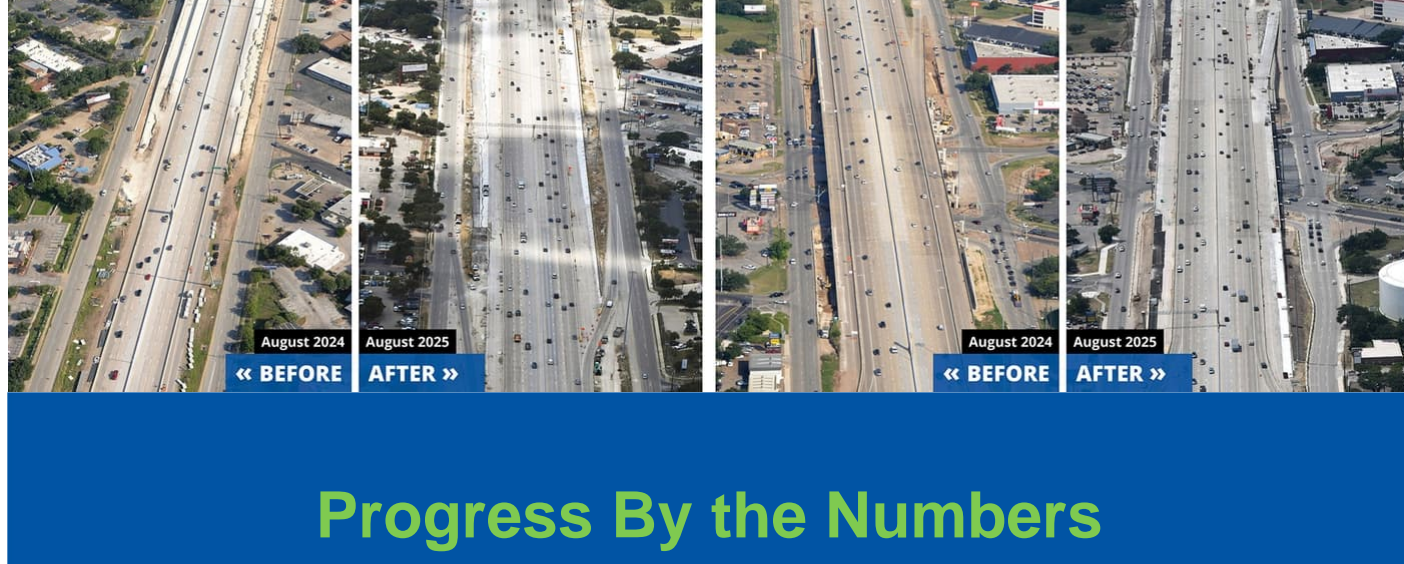

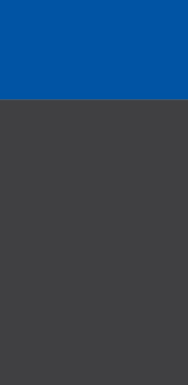
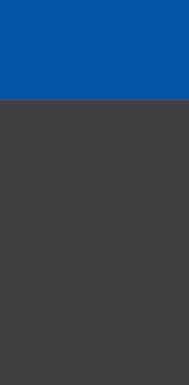
Construction Progress: Before and After

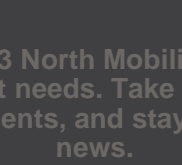
As of August 2025, the 183 North Mobility Project contractor, Great Hills Constructors, has employed up to
