




PROJECT OVERVIEW



- **Project Limits:**
SH 45 to MoPac/Loop 1
- **Project Length:**
9 miles on US 183
- **Total Project Cost:**
\$612 Million
- **Project Status:**
Design-Build



The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority is bringing mobility improvements to US HWY 183 by building the 183 North Mobility Project which will include:



Adds two express lanes in each direction



Adds a collector distributor to the southbound MoPac frontage road




High-tech traffic monitoring system for improved traffic management and emergency response



Creates direct connect from MoPac via new express lanes

- Increased **mobility** in corridor
- **Safe connectivity for pedestrians** throughout the corridor through continuous, ADA compliant sidewalks
- Connected **bicycle lanes at specific intersections** throughout the corridor
- **Better visibility** through upgrades to 568 lights with LED, high mast lighting
- **Reduced traffic** noise through next generation, concrete surfacing
- Improved **response times** for emergency vehicles






