### **Construction Begins on the** 183 North Mobility Project The Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (Mobility Authority) is pleased to

announce the official kickoff of the 183 North Mobility Project. Work begins soon on the nine-mile stretch of US 183 between SH 45 North and MoPac. The 183 North Mobility Project aims to improve mobility, reduce congestion, and provide more reliable travel times for transit and emergency responders along this portion of US 183. To address issues on and off the roadway, the project includes the construction of two

express lanes in each direction and the addition of a general-purpose lane to bring the number of non-tolled lanes to four in each direction in addition to other improvements.
