

## **Nightly Pavement Grinding** Nightly pavement grinding, a process where part of the roadway is removed to level

and smooth the surface, has kicked off on the 183 North Mobility Project at Lakeline Dr. and will continue moving southbound on US 183 over the next several months. This work is Phase 1 of implementing the project's Next Generation Concrete Surface to give the corridor a smoother and more comfortable ride. Next Generation Concrete Surface refers to an innovative smooth concrete pavement surface that provides desirable friction characteristics. During this work, night lighting will be used to keep workers safe, and the noise level anticipated from the resurfacing of the roadway will stay within the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) guidelines.




