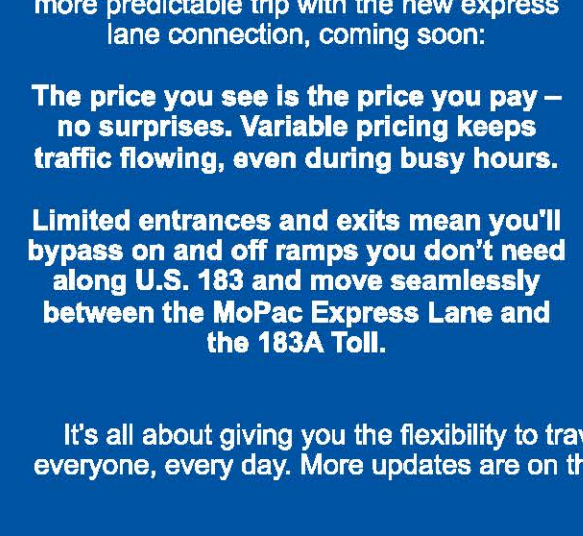

You'll soon be able to choose a smoother, more predictable trip with the new express lane connection, coming soon:

The price you see is the price you pay – no surprises. Variable pricing keeps traffic flowing, even during busy hours.

Limited entrances and exits mean you'll bypass on and off ramps you don't need along U.S. 183 and move seamlessly between the MoPac Express Lane and the 183A Toll.

Free Lanes for Every Day



The project improvements aren't just for the express lanes. Drivers in the free lanes benefit from:

Free general-purpose lanes added earlier in the project last year.

Enhanced auxiliary lanes for easier merging.

Upgraded infrastructure, including improved lighting and drainage.

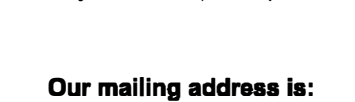

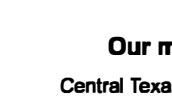
