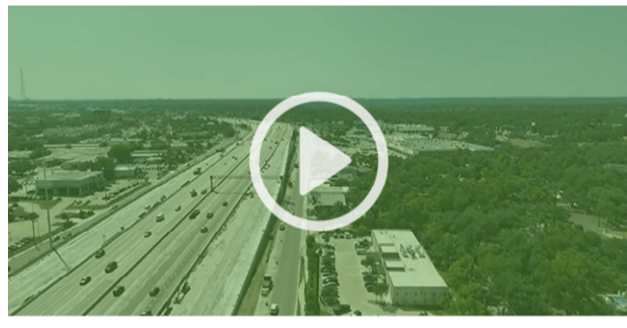


Check Out Our Latest Drone Footage and What's Ahead!
