

A Seamless Link Between US 183 and MoPac

Existing non-tolled access between US 183 and MoPac remains.



But now there's another option for when you need it. ▶



As a part of the 183 North Mobility Project, we've made operational improvements to the connection between US 183 and MoPac via the 183 Express Lanes.

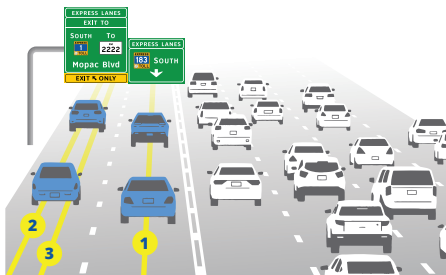
The interchange now includes a direct connector (DC) structure connecting the MoPac Express Lane to the 183 Express Lanes, in both northbound and southbound directions.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Southbound 183 Express Lanes

Drivers in the southbound 183 Express Lanes wishing to exit the express lanes prior to entering the MoPac Express Lane can take the 183 Express Lanes exit to Braker Ln. to access the MoPac general purpose lanes and Steck Ave.

Drivers who continue on past the Braker Ln. exit have several options when traveling southbound:



- ▶ **Option 1:** Stay in the right lane to continue southbound until the 183 Express Lanes merge into US 183 to access Burnet Rd., Payton Gin Rd., Lamar Blvd. and I-35.
- ▶ **Option 2:** Use the left lane to access the direct connector to MoPac and continue on to the southbound MoPac Express Lane.
- ▶ **Option 3:** Use the left lane to access the direct connector and merge onto the collector distributor road, which is a non-tolled signal bypass to the southbound MoPac frontage road.



The on-ramp from Steck Ave. now involves a connection to the CD road that bypasses signals. Drivers can enter the MoPac mainlanes before Far West Blvd.

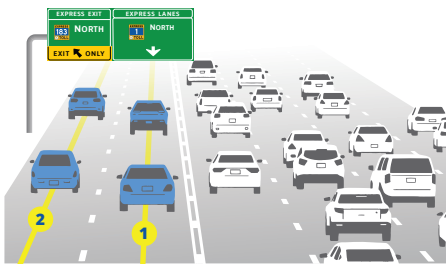

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

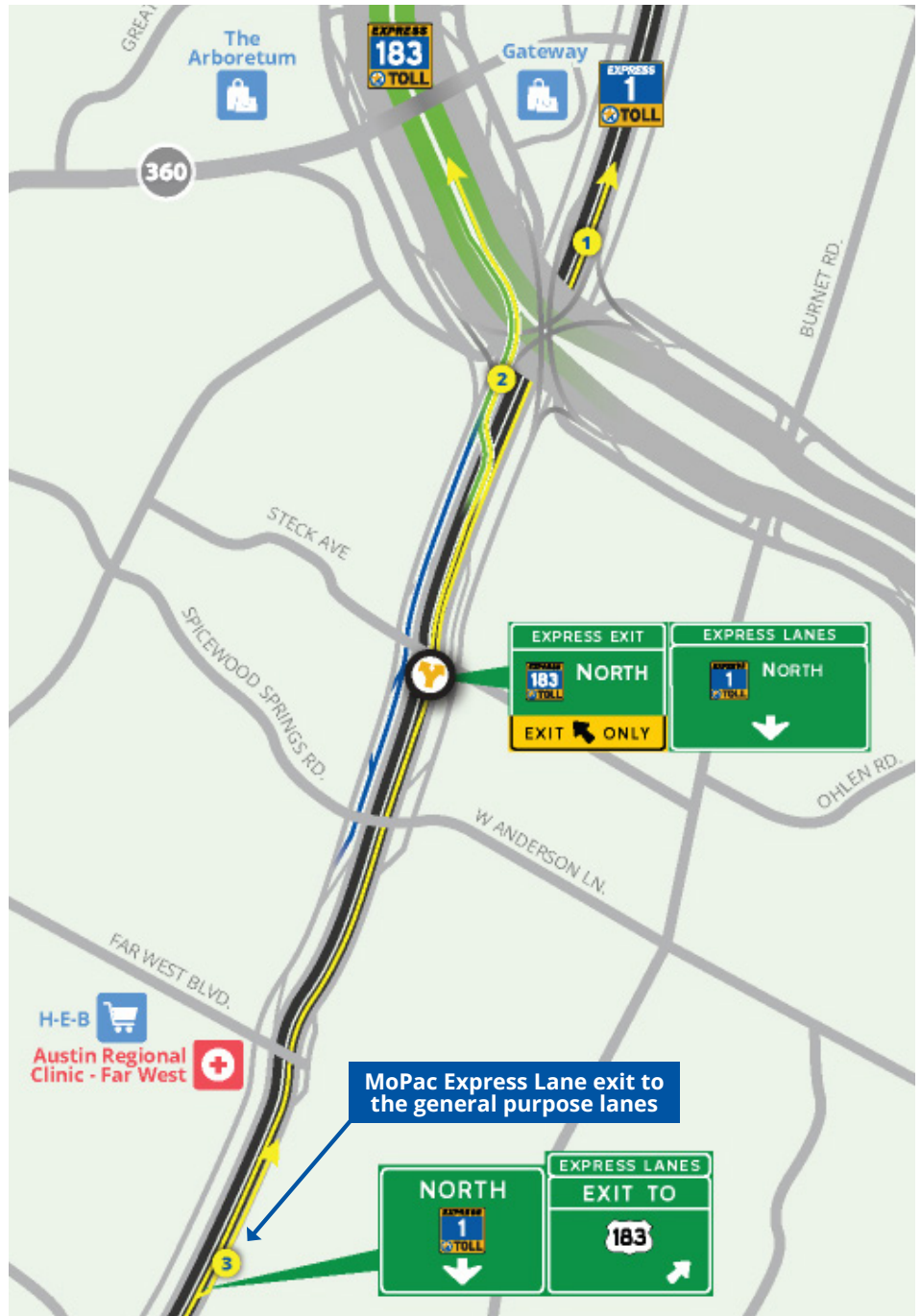
Northbound MoPac Express Lane

To connect directly to the 183 Express Lanes from MoPac, drivers must be in the MoPac Express Lane.

Drivers in the MoPac Express Lane have several options when driving north:



- ▶ **Option 1:** Drivers will still have the option to continue north in the MoPac Express Lane to the Parmer Ln. exit and points beyond. They should be in the right lane to stay on the MoPac Express Lane.
- ▶ **Option 2:** Drivers in the left lane will take the direct connector to the northbound 183 Express Lanes and can continue to their desired exit.
- ▶ **Option 3:** To access Loop 360 Capital of Texas Hwy., Great Hills Trail, or Braker Ln., drivers in the MoPac Express Lane must follow signs to exit the MoPac Express Lane toward US 183 and use the existing direct connector to the US 183 general purpose lanes. Drivers will bypass these exits in the 183 Express Lanes.
